Learn how to edit digital photos with PhotoShop Elements so that you can restore damaged photos, create a variety of special effects and make them the exact size you would like. Participants will learn how to create composite photos (bring in people from multiple photos), remove unwanted information from images, manage their files and more. Learn how to distribute your photos by printing them, emailing them, using them in presentations, and posting them on a web page. Emphasis will be given to using digital images to enhance the classroom experience for your students. Participants may bring in their own photos.

Prerequisite: Basic Computer Skills, but the stronger your computer skills, the more you will learn.
